Cherry Capital Airport Sees Increased Passenger Enplanement During the Month of May *Michigan's ONLY Airport to Report Increase*

(Traverse City, MI) June 29, 2009 – Cherry Capital Airport officials are pleased to announce that **the month of May saw increased passenger enplanement over last year** during the same month (May 2008).
