

## **New Denver Service Takes to the Skies**

(Traverse City, Michigan) March 4, 2008 – Cherry Capital Airport officials are pleased to announce that non-stop service to and from Denver, Colorado will begin June 5, 2008. Just in time for the summer tourist season, United Airlines will provide the inbound and outbound service to Denver International Airport (DEN) via regional jet service on a CRJ-700, which is configured to 66 seats with first class seating.

Adding to the roster of flights taking off and landing at Cherry Capital Airport (TVC), the new United Airlines Denver (DEN) flight is an example of the continued commitment to the regional traveler on behalf of The Northwestern Regional Airport Commission. Visitors to the Cherry Capital airline terminal complex will find convenience every step of the way - close parking, electronic check-in computers, advanced baggage screening, and an outdoor garden for ticketed passengers. For those passengers who are dropped off, there is a weather resistant canopy entrance. Once inside the terminal complex, passengers may take their ticket to one of fourteen cherry wood counters in the east sunlit hall and check-in with the airline of choice. Or passengers may bypass the line, swipe a credit card at an electronic check-in computer, print out a boarding pass and be on their way.

Other travel services include rental cars and taxis on site, making certain that those visiting the Cherry Capital Of The World get to where they need to go conveniently and efficiently. Passengers will find rental car purveyors Avis, Budget, Enterprise, Hertz, and National/Alamo just a step away from the baggage claim area.
